
At the school we met our hosts which then took us to their homes to stay in for the duration of the trip. Some of our hosts took us for a trip around Reykjavík

And I got to the sea to see it's beauty




l even got to see some northern lights outside!!!




After that we went home and had some lovely dinner, which was marinated chicken with olives. Then we relaxed, talked and went to bed.



The next day on Monday we went to the mall after getting shown around the school by Helga (one of their teachers). And well...










In the city center we saw the church and many points of interest such as gift shops, restaurants, caffés and many

And then some sleep.




On the third day we went to school as usual and then on a trip to the university.






Once we got back from the university we went for some ice cream in WINTER and then decided to go hunt some northern lights.



Humorous that after we got home we could see them out of our windows.




Golden Circle tour!!!

Next stop, the Geysir Geothermal Area where we got some small lunch for the trip handed out to us.










Then it was time for some delicious tomato soup!

After the classes we went to the Blue Lagoon. And well it was pretty good!














I also got a pretty cool picture, as we were heading back, of a mountain with just the sun above it between the clouds!

On Friday we went to school, but weren't there for a long time.




After school we went to Fly Over Iceland where unfortunately we could not take photos or film, but it was a really great experience!






Then we went to a pizza place where in total there were 27 pizzas for everyone. And also as the tradition calls we cheered on for the Icelandic handball team!

In the evening we went to a japanese restaurant called Tokyo for some sushi.




We also went swimming to the pools, but I didn't get any photos of that for reasons. Then we went home to sleep.

Last day and you know what time it is!!




