The ideal school "Wouldn't you like to create your own school?"

- What if you really had the chance to design the school of your dreams?
- The kids will learn and practise how to **research**, **analyse**, **reflect** on their own experience and future expectations.
- The students will get introduced to graphic programs.
- They will test their ability to work in a team.
- The work includes evaluation of the current curriculum and deciding what to keep, what to improve and why (reasoning!).
- The end project is a <u>website</u> and a <u>visual presentation</u>.

Step 1

First you'll be working on your own using the brainstorming method.

Make a list of pros and cons regarding your current school. Make sure you consider all the aspects of your school (subjects, atmosphere, teachers, food, equipment, schoolmates, location, design and decorations, free-time facilities, sports facilities, school clubs, library, lockers, technology, projects).

Step 2

Now you will be assigned to your group by your teacher and your task is to contrast and compare your ideas with your teammates' ideas. Put your lists together and highlight the five best and five worst aspects that you can all agree on. Make sure everybody agrees with the final arguments.

Step 3

Find an authority in your school to confront/consult your ideas with. This can be a teacher, headmaster,... This should help you get a new perspective and see things from a different point of view, considering teachers are an important part of school life.



Step 4

Go back to your groups and discuss the feedback that you got. If you find yourselves in a disagreement with the authority, work on finding a compromise.

Step 5

With all that you've learnt, have a look at the resources down below and compare them with your results to create the final project (website and a visual presentation). Are they different? Are any parts of the results similar?
