NAME OF THE ACTIVITY

Sarka

Trees in London memory game

Time: 10-20 minutes

Language level: Elementary to Upper-Intermediate Language focus: different tree species in London

Aim: Ss will memorize and learn the names of trees found in the Check

Republic and London in English

Ss will learn to recognize different trees, their leaves and fruit

Preparation:

Materials:

cut up tree cards

tree cards, scissors

## Procedure:

- T elicits names of trees in L1 with the help of pictures and teaches how to say in English
- 2-5 Ss
- Ss shuffle the cards and put them face down on a table
- Ss take it in turns to take 4 cards look at the cards and keep the cards if all 4 of them depict the same tree
- Ss put back all the 4 cards face down even if just one card is different
- Ss need to remember the location of 4 trees that are the same to be able to pick the 4 card of the same tree
